We believe that this is the correct decision and since the Convention Center made it the potential to financially cripple the Region has been avoided.

For now, NCCNA is unable to offer any refunds. NCCNA will be making recommendations to the Regional Service Committee (RSC) and that body will review and decide if and how refunds could be done. It is important to us that we get the information out to the Fellowship, as quickly as we can, given the uncertainty that the Statewide shelter in-place order has caused around the Convention. There is still much work to be accomplished in order to fully understand the impact to the Region, and it will be done. This process may take some time, but we will be working diligently to come up with a reasonable solution to address the concerns of all who registered for the event.
